Congratulations on having your English 10600/10800 project chosen to be displayed at the ICaP Showcase of Student Work. We would like to be able to archive all of the showcase submissions this year so that future students and teachers can have access to them as examples of good student work and so the program can keep an ongoing record of the kinds of work that are representative of the different approaches to teaching English 10600.

We would like your permission to 1) archive digital photos of your displays and 2) archive the original project, both on CD and on our program website (<http://www.sla.purdue.edu/academic/engl/ICaP/>). You have been chosen to be part of the showcase because your instructor thinks your work is worthy of sharing with others, so you can rest assured that you and your projects will be treated with respect.

You are under no obligation to allow the program to archive your work, and your decision will, of course, have no influence on your grade in any class.
