

ICaP–GradSEA Travel Grants

Fall 2017 and Spring 2018

This academic year, ICaP will award up to ten (10) \$200 travel grants for English graduate students who give presentations on writing pedagogy at academic conferences. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis, and can be submitted until April 16, 2018. Graduate students will be notified if the total amount of funds are dispersed before April 16, 2018; however, GradSEA and ICaP intend to seek additional funding from institutional entities if this situation occurs.

ELIGIBILITY

Graduate students who present any time during the academic year are eligible. You can only be awarded one travel grant per academic year (Fall & Spring semesters). If you are rejected in the Fall, you might apply in the Spring for a conference you are going to attend during that semester.

PEDAGOGY TRAVEL GRANT RULES

To be eligible for consideration, you must be presenting on pedagogy. It does not have to be a pedagogical conference, but your presentation must be about teaching. GradSEA representatives will judge the awards (as they do with the other grad student travel awards).

Those who are going to be awarded one of the travel grants will be asked to write a short piece about the conference for the GradSEA website.

APPLICATION PROCESS

In order to apply for the travel grant, send a PDF with the following materials:

1. Rationale: what is the importance of the presentation (200-300 words)
2. Information about the conference (title, dates, location)
3. Information on having additional financial support for the conference (this will not exclude you from the grant)
4. A copy of your conference proposal
5. Proof of acceptance to the conference

Note: Proof of conference attendance (hotel bill, boarding pass, etc) will be necessary for reimbursement. You will also need to use the CONCUR travel system to be reimbursed, and requests using that system must be completed and submitted at least two weeks before travel.
